I am a 50 year resident of Orinda (I live on Corte Bombero)and I am quite concerned about the zoning regulations being considered at this upcoming meeting on September 30. The 4 sites in South Orinda all border our only road in and out, Moraga Way. Adding that many new residents and cars to an already always congested Moraga Way will make evacuation during a fire impossible! 3 of the sites, 433 Moraga way, 451 Moraga. Way and 501 Moraga way are within 1000 feet of each other. Currently it's near impossible to enter Moraga Way unless we go to the light at Glorietta. Dear Mr. Rust,

Thank you for reaching out regarding your concern about flag protocol.

I want to address two points from your message. First, your initial correspondence did not reach us, as it was sent to an incorrect email address. The email included an extra "r" at the end of "info" (infor@mofd.org instead of info@mofd.org). This is the first communication we have received from you on this matter.

Regarding the flag at half-staff, MOFD adheres to all official directives from the President of the United States concerning the U.S. flag, irrespective of political party. Our flags were lowered to half-staff in accordance with a presidential proclamation and were subsequently returned to full staff as specified in that directive.
